1. Title of the Practice: Haemoglobin Check-up Camp

2 Goals:

* To locate the problem of Anemia

3. The Context:

The people in the vicinity of the college, especially women and girls are suffering from Anemia and they are not aware of the problem. The Haemoblobin check-up is one of the ways of looking at the problem.

4. Practice:

The college has made special efforts to organize a Haemoglobin Check-up camp in the collaboration with Alumni Association, Shree Sai Charitable Trust, Pioneer Institute, National Service Scheme and Vocational Training Centre. It was organized on 16th September 2023 on the campus.

- **5. Evidence of success**: In this camp, more than two hundred students (female) and teaching and non-teaching staff benefitted from some suggestions from the trained medical practitioners.
- **6. Problems encountered**: As the college is situated in a rural area and it is far away from towns which have well-equipped medical laboratories, blood samples were taken to the laboratories and reports were shared with the students after almost a fortnight.
- **7. Resources required**: It was done with the help of Non-government Organizations which are mentioned above.

Best Practice-2

1. Title of the Practice: Street Play on the Awareness of Tuberculosis

2. Goals:

*To make people aware of Tuberculosis as a life-threatening disease.

- **3. Context:** The Red-Cross Unit in the college had received the guidelines from the District Red-Cross Association about the Awareness Programme on Tuberculosis. As per the guidelines, the college organized performances of street play on Tuberculosis. It was done so to sensitize.
- **4 Practice**: The Red Cross Unit in the college organized street plays at public places in the vicinity of the college. These plays were performed on 08th November 2023. In these performances, 33 students and 03 faculties from the college took an active part.
- **Evidence of success**: 33 students and 03 faculties attended performances along with audience at the public places.
- **6 Problems encountered**: The Red Cross Unit in the college works without funding and the college had to make financial provisions.
- **Resources required:** The willingness of students and devoted teaching staff having knowledge of performance studies.
