In the academic year 2021-2022, the following activities were conducted by the Department of English:

**Guest lecturers:** Prof . Ganesh Wagh, HOD, Dept. Of English of Annasaheb Awate College, Manchar was invited on 31 December 2021 to guide the students on the topic ' How to score good marks in the examination? 
