Annual Report of the Department of Political Science – Academic Year 2021-22

1. Voter Registration Camp under Voter Awareness Campaign

On 22nd November 2021, the Department of Political Science organized a Voter Registration Camp for students who had completed 18 years of age. The camp was inaugurated by Hon.
