1. Voter Registration Camp under Voter Awareness Campaign

On 25th November 2022, the Department of Political Science organized a Voter Registration Camp for students who had completed 18 years of age. The camp was inaugurated by Hon. Tehsildar of Ambegaon Taluka, Mrs. Rama Joshi. On this occasion, the Acting Principal Dr. Dnyaneshwar Walhekar, Nodal Officer Prof. S. L. Nevkar, Prof. S. S. Ghaytadke, Prof. H. S. Devare, Talathi Mr. Rahul Pandare, Revenue Officer Mr. Mauli Ghodekar, and a large number of students were present.

A total of 61 students registered their names online for the voters' list. As per the directives of the District Collector, a Mega Camp was conducted in 450 colleges on the same day to increase the number of new voters. Tehsildar Mrs. Joshi emphasized that voting is the foundation of democracy and exercising one's right to vote is the duty of every citizen. She appealed to students to enroll their names and participate actively in the democratic process.

2. Celebration of Constitution Day

On 26th November 2022 (Saturday), Constitution Day was celebrated jointly by the Department of Political Science, Student Welfare Board, and NSS Unit of B. D. Kale College, Ghodegaon. The program was graced by the presence of Hon. Acting President of the Institution, Mr. Tukaram Namdevrao Kale, Acting Principal Dr. Dnyaneshwar Walhekar, Vice Principal Dr. Balasaheb Gawhale, Student Welfare Officer Prof. Kailas Umbare, NSS Programme Officer Dr. Vallabh Karandikar, Head of Commerce Dr. Prabhakar Mokal, teaching and non-teaching staff, and about 600 students from all streams.
